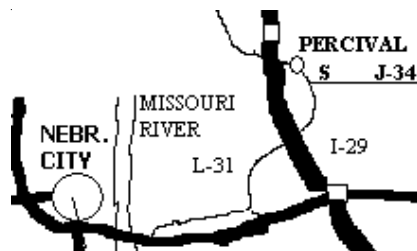
Routes: Experience fall colors, crisp morning air, and warm sun from miles of hard surfaced country roads. Five routes are available. The 23 & 32 mile routes stay on flat country roads. The 40, 54, & 64 mile rides climb to the top of the bluffs, guaranteed to provide colorful views and exciting downhill.

Breakfast: The Percival Fire Department will be serving pancakes, sausage and juice or coffee at the Station for \$4 adults & \$3 children. **Pay for breakfast on the day of the ride. Do not send breakfast money with the application fee.**

Ride Start: Fire Station on Road L-31 in Percival, Iowa. Start anytime between 8 & 9 a.m. Register between 7 & 9 a.m.



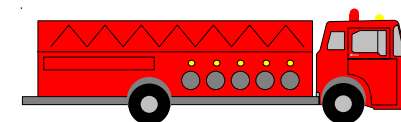

HELMETS REQUIRED

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

In consideration of being permitted to participate in the Wish Ride, I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

1. Acknowledge, agree, and represent that I understand the nature of bicycling activities and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such activity. I further acknowledge that the activity will be conducted over public roads and facilities open to the public during the activity and upon which the hazards of traveling are expected. I further agree and warrant that if, at any time, I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation in the activity.

2. Fully understand that (a) bicycling activities involve risks and dangers of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death; (b) these risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the activity, the condition in which the activity takes place, or the negligence of the "releasees" named below; (c) there may be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs and damages I incur as a result of my participation or that of the minor in the Activity.

3. Hereby release, discharge and covenant not to sue the Club, the LAB their respective administrators, directors, agents officers, members, volunteers, and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place, (each considered one of the "Releasees" herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the "Releasees": or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if despite this release and waiver of liability, assumptions of risk and indemnity agreement I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the Releasees from any litigation, expenses, attorney fees, loss damage, or cost which may incur as the result of such a claim.

I have read this agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and have signed it freely without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held invalid, the balance notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.

Parent or Guardian must sign for Children under 18 to participate.
