This route will be lightly supported so bring  
plenty of water with you. Restrooms and drinking  
fountains at all trailheads approximately  
every 6-7 miles.

ROUTES/MILES

**1st** Trailhead is at Holmesville, NE with restrooms  
and drinking fountains. is approx 7.5 miles.  
(round trip mileage is 15 miles)

**2nd** Trailhead is at Blue Springs, NE with restrooms  
and drinking fountains is approx. 12.5 miles  
(round trip mileage is 25 miles)

**3rd** Trailhead is at Barneston, NE with restrooms  
and drinking fountains is approx. 18.5 miles  
(round trip mileage is 37 miles)

Continuing on to Marysville, KS will be about 30  
miles total with (round trip being 60)
